## Proposal for Visit to RBI Monetary Museum

Accounts, Finance & Commerce Club and the BCom Department propose to organize a field visit to the RBI Monetary Museum. This visit will be open to all BCom students of NLDC.

Date: Sat 24 August 2024

Time: 1100 AM - 0100 PM

Venue: Reserve Bank of India Monetary Museum, Phirozshah Mehta Road Fort, Mumbai

## **Objectives:**

- To provide students with a practical and engaging learning experience that complements their academic knowledge in finance, economics, and banking.
- To gain insights into the history of currency and banking in India by exploring the RBI Monetary Museum(RBIMM).
- To understand the evolution of monetary policy and appreciate the role of the Reserve Bank of India in the economic development of the country.

## **Detailed** Plan

- 1. Arrival and Check-In at RBIMM (1045 AM 1100 AM)
  - Students are requested to reach the RBI Monetary Museum by 1045 AM to complete check-in procedures and be ready for the start of the program.
  - Students will need to arrange their own transportation to the museum.

# 2. Museum Tour and Documentary Viewing (1100 AM - 1200 NOON)

- To manage the number of students and avoid overcrowding, the group will be divided into two sessions:
  - Session A (1100 AM 1200 NOON): 25 students will watch the documentary film about the history and significance of currency and banking in India.
  - Session B (1100 AM 1200 NOON): 25 students will take a guided tour of the museum to explore exhibits and artifacts related to India's monetary history.
- After one hour, the groups will switch sessions:
  - Session A (1200 NOON 0100 PM): The students who watched the documentary will now take the guided tour of the museum.
  - Session B (1200 NOON 0100 PM): The students who toured the museum will watch the documentary film.

### 3. Debrief and Feedback (0100 PM)

• A brief debriefing session will be held at the end of the visit for students to share their experiences and feedback.

### **Student Responsibilities**

- Transportation: Students are responsible for arranging and covering their own transportation to and from the RBI Monetary Museum.
- **Punctuality:** Students must arrive at the venue atleast by 1030AM to ensure a smooth start to the program.
- **Conduct:** Students are expected to maintain a respectful and professional demeanor throughout the visit, adhering to the Museum's guidelines and regulations.
- Undertaking: Students must submit a duly signed Undertaking Form from their parents before the visit.

• Dress Code: Decent & Semi-Formal

We anticipate that this visit will provide a valuable and enriching experience for the students, enhancing their understanding of India's financial history and the role of central banking.
