About the Event

Mind Marathon was organized by the **Department of Economics** with the objective of enhancing students' knowledge, analytical thinking, and quick decision-making skills in Economics. The event was structured into four engaging and competitive rounds.

Round 1 – Rapid Fire

This was the warm-up round. Participants were asked **15 questions** based on Economics and current affairs. Teams had installed a **buzzer application** to answer quickly. The round tested their speed, alertness, and accuracy.

Round 2 – EconoQuest (Quest for Knowledge)

This round focused on conceptual clarity and application-based questions. Participants were required to analyse economic situations and apply their knowledge effectively.

Round 3 – Ecoduku

This innovative round required participants to solve a **6×6 Sudoku puzzle** using six Economics-related terms instead of numbers. The six terms were:

GDP, CPI, Tax, FDI, Debt, and RBI.

Students had to place these terms correctly while maintaining the Sudoku pattern rules. This round tested logical thinking, conceptual understanding, and analytical ability.

From the total **18 participating teams**, **14 team was eliminated** at this stage based on their performance.

Round 4 – Hunt It – Find It (Treasure Hunt)

The top **4 teams** qualified for the final round titled “**Hunt It – Find It**”, which was conducted as a Treasure Hunt. Teams had to solve economics-based clues and locate hidden hints within the venue. This round tested teamwork, presence of mind, and quick problem-solving skills. The participating teams reached at this round got 5 clues at different places in the different corner of the college. The team that successfully solved all five clues in the shortest time was declared the winner of the final round. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation and healthy competition.

The winners were announced during the valedictory ceremony. The event concluded successfully with appreciation for the organizing committee and participants.
